Board Meeting Minutes 2/28/13

Meeting called to order by President Lion Roberta at 6:03 pm.

NEW BUSINESS:

Presentations by Kim and Lion Janet for the janitorial job. Lion Debbie B. advised that a statement of work should be given to anyone that wants to bid on the job. Discussion between board members & a motion was put forth that we as a club; board & members, should put together a wish list to keep the bar & club clean. 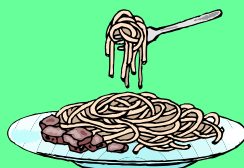
MARCH CRAB FEED

MIGRAINES
