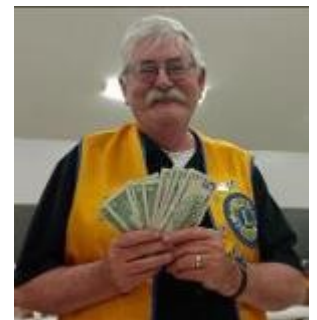
Grounds crew members are appointed by club manager and are not board positions.
