
Minutes - Joint Board Meeting - June 28, 2018 (continued)

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- President Sheri First line dancing class to be held on Tuesday, July 31st @ 6:30 pm. First class is free \$5.00 thereafter.
- President Sheri Air conditioning project for kitchen tabled due to waiting for a few more bids and verification of the funds to be transferred from the Lioness. Lion Sierra said she would meet with Lioness Ronna and take care of closing the Lioness account and submit funds to the Lions. Discussion was held regarding the air conditioning, replacement/repair of the outer door with new locks and the repair to the walk-in compressor. Motion was made to schedule the repairs after bids are reviewed. A special board meeting to be held as soon as bids received.
- Treasurer Kim ATM procedures revised. The ATM will be used for special events only with a \$45 non-refundable deposit due with rental agreement. In addition, each transaction will be charged a \$3.00 fee.
- Treasurer Kim Locks will be changed, and keys authorized and monitored for persons requiring access. There are too many keys out and we must control access to the building.
- President Sheri Birthday dinner (1st general meeting) will be handled by "Chef Delores" and her committee. The 2nd general meeting will be meatloaf dinner prepared by Chefs Gertie, Sally, Sierra and other committee members. Side dishes and salads requested.
