Smoking Policy – Loma Rica Foothill Lions Club

I am sure a lot of you have heard the whispers and talk about the smoking policy of our club. Well, let me clear a few things up. Yes, there have been quite a few members commenting about the cigarette smoking, the unpleasant smell in the bar, and health concerns. These members feel they can't get friends and neighbors to join the club due to the smoke and smell; and they would be more active, and enjoy the club more, if it was a non-smoking facility.

The members who smoke want the policy to stay the same as it is now. They feel they are dues-paying members and should have a say in the policy; and they don't believe new people will join our club even if we have a no-smoking policy. Everyone's point of view and feelings are important and should be taken into consideration; therefore, I have determined the matter should be brought to the full membership for their decision.

On April 18th at our general meeting, there will be a confidential ballot vote on the smoking policy. Each member present will be given a ballot to vote on their individual preference. The ballots will be numbered but no signature on the ballot will be required; as to not hinder an honest vote, with only one ballot per member present. You will be required to sign for the ballot, and the list will be confidential. A committee assigned by the President will count the votes and submit the final count to the President.

Members unable to attend the meeting may mail their ballot to the club. The mailed vote must be received by April 17, 2019, to be valid. The votes will then be added to the count at the general meeting by the committee named by the President.
