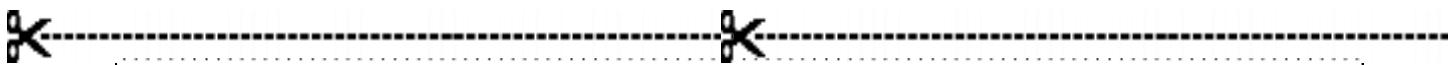

SUNSHINE REPORT

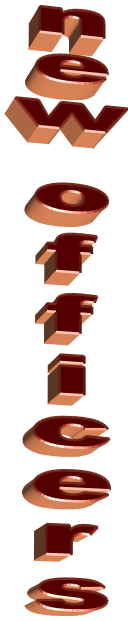
LION DIANA WHEELER is your new Sunshine Reporter—Please get all your input to her - 741-1502
