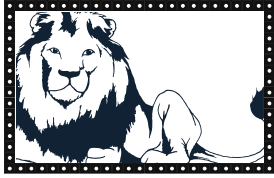

MINUTES – BOARD MEETING – AUGUST 25, 2016

Meeting called to order at 6:04 pm by President Kim Hall. 13 members present, 1 absent, 2 vacancies, 1 guest (Lion John Stevens).

Lion Susie presented the financial reports. Motion to accept the financial report by Lion Linda – 2nd by Lion Mike – no discussion – Vote – MSP.

Lion Sally submitted \$450 in dues to Treasurer.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Lion Sheri gave update on car show. So far there are 26 entries but it always picks up closer to the date. Raffle prizes are needed and the wooden signs need repair or they need to be replaced.

Lion Mike – Proceeds of the concert will be taken to the Middletown Lions Club on Sept. 14th. Anyone wishing to attend, please notify Mike by Sept. 4th. Lion Susie suggested that the club donate an additional \$400 to make the donation \$4000. Motion was made to accept this recommendation – vote – MSP.

Lion Linda – Spaghetti dinner fundraiser on Sept. 10th. Flyers are out and everything ready to go.
