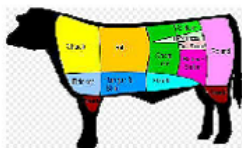

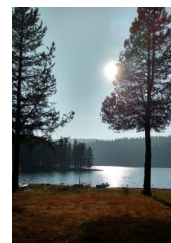

Minutes – Board Meeting – August 23, 2018



The meeting was called to order by President Sheri at 6:05 pm. 12 members were present with 2 members absent – 1 vacancy. The guests, Ms. Peggy Taylor and Ms. Lulu Jacobsen, both prospective new members, were introduced to the board members. Ms. Taylor has completed the requirements and her application was voted on and approved by the board. Ms. Jacobsen has one meeting and the orientation process to complete. Both ladies explained their reasons for wanting to become members of the Foothill Lions Club.

Treasurer Kim submitted the financials for review. Discussion was held and a motion to accept the financials as presented was made by Lion Linda and 2nd by Lion Joni. Vote – MSP.

Secretary Sally submitted \$280 in dues funds to the Treasurer.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

President Sheri updated the schedule for the work crew traveling to Redding to assist in the Distribution Center. Members wishing to go should meet at the club before 9:00 am on Wednesday, August 29th to carpool to Redding. We will work from 12:00 pm to 3:00 pm.

President Sheri/Lion Gertie – update and lengthy discussion of the hall rental agreement was held. Lion Gertie presented her recommendations to the board and Lion Susie will update the agreement. A meeting is scheduled to go over the document and finalize for submission to the board.

President Sheri – The air conditioning project for the kitchen has been completed, the walk-in compressor has been repaired but the back-door project has not been completed.

President Sheri – Line Dancing will continue until further notice on Tuesdays. The club portion of the proceeds for the last class was \$95.

Treasurer/Bar Manager Kim said the pool tournaments are over and Sunday Football will begin soon. If people still want to play pool or play darts, they can play at the Sunday Football gathering.

Lion Sally advised the board that the North Butte District Cabinet meeting will be held on Saturday, September 15th in Paradise. She has copies of the registration form which is due by September 1st. Lion Sally will be attending to represent the Foothill Lions Club. New member, Ms. Peggy Taylor, may go with her.

President Sheri – update on upcoming car show. There are 30 cars presently registered for the show. Raffle prizes are needed.

President Sheri asked Lion Linda about the repairs on the Gazebo. Lion Linda said that Lion Bob and Lion John need to meet to discuss the required repairs. President Sheri said that the safety concerns should be corrected before the Car Show, if possible. This was tabled for further discussion. In addition, Lion Linda advised the ladies bathroom project had been completed.

NEW BUSINESS:

Lion Sally advised the board that she would be attending an assembly at the Foothill Intermediate School to promote the Lions Peace Poster Contest on Wednesday, August 29th. Lion Sally also advised the board that the Student Speaker Kit had been ordered.

Minutes – Board Meeting (cont.) – August 23, 2018



President Sheri – Discussion was held and copies of the flyer for An In-Sight-Full-Day for District 4-C1 that will be held on September 28th in Chico, was presented. All members are welcome to attend this function. Again, flyers are available for details, location and time.

President Sheri – a vaccine clinic will be held at the club on Sunday, August 26th from 9:30 am to 11:30 am. Cats must be in carriers. The flyer is posted on the bulletin board and on the outside doors, which contains price list and vaccines available.

Lion Susie requested the alarm company be notified that two other members will be available for emergency calls. The two members volunteering were Lion Bill High and President Sheri, as both live close to the club. Apparently, spiders and/or spiderwebs are causing the alarm to go off in the “wee” hours of the morning. Lion Susie and Lion Jeff will be traveling, so other emergency numbers are needed. In addition, Lion Bill requested that we get a listing of the code numbers and when they are being used to enter the building for review. Treasurer Kim will contact the alarm company.

Lion Laurie asked if purse holders can be attached to the bar for members to hang their purses rather than placing them on the floor. Discussion was held, and the matter will be investigated.

Lion Cindi asked if water can be furnished for the line dancing classes. It was suggested that pitchers of water and plastic glasses be made available.

President Sheri advised the board that ducts in the club need repaired or replaced. Apparently, they are very old and inefficient. Lion Susie made a motion to get bids for replacement and Lion Bill 2nd the motion. A vote was held and passed.

Lion Linda told the board the menu/theme for the September dinners will be Asian Fusion (Chinese Food) at the Birthday Dinner on September 6th prepared by Lion Jean-Marie and her committee with the 2nd meeting be Lion Linda’s Chicken-fried steak with the “fixins”.

A lengthy discussion was held regarding the Lions Community Breakfast (formerly the Lioness Breakfast). Lion Sierra said 74 breakfasts were prepared by Lions volunteers with assistance from the Scouts troop. President Sheri told the board that volunteers were needed to assist with the breakfast. Also, the menu was discussed, as well as the viability of continuing the project. If there aren’t enough Lions volunteers that will help, we may not be able to continue the community service breakfast. More discussion is needed on the matter.

OTHER:

President Sheri read the correspondence. A Thank You letter was received from a Cascade Fire victim, Mr. James Miller, and read to the board. A letter from the Salvation Army for donations was read but the board voted “not at this time”.

Motion was made by to adjourn the meeting at 7:15 pm by Lion Joni and 2nd by Lion Mary. Vote – MSP – Meeting adjourned. Goodnight all!
